Assistant Treasurer's Report

The Woman's Club is grateful for the generosity of its members, both cash/check donations and gifts-in-kind for our various planned giving opportunities each month. They make a huge difference for our club operations, the building, and all the various charities that we support.

In years past, annual summary donation acknowledgement letters have been prepared for gifts made during the previous calendar year. The process requires many steps to locate and consolidate the information into a letter. It was done so that people had a record for the charitable deduction on their tax returns. In the last few years, the tax tables were changed so that many people no longer itemize their deductions, making these letters unnecessary in many cases.



The Finance Committee has revised the policy for these charitable donation acknowledgement letters. The default will be <u>not</u> to prepare letters for the members. If someone would like an acknowledgement letter, they need to include a note with their gift (cash, check, gift-in-kind) that they would like a letter of acknowledgement, and one will happily be prepared. <u>Whether you</u> want a letter or not, please continue to include your receipts with your in-kind

gifts, as it is the only way we can quantify the value of the donations that we make to the organizations.
